Corona Heights park has some of the best views in San Francisco, as well as vibrant spring wildflower displays of California poppy, foot-steps of spring, mule's ears, and Johnny jump-up.

The prominent red rock outcrops are radiolarian chert. There is also an excellent example of a "slickenside," a smooth, polished surface between two masses of rock that is created by tectonic sliding. This slick vertical rock face can best be seen from Beaver and 15th streets.

In the late 1800s, Corona Heights was quarried by the infamous Gray Brothers for brick-making materials. The park's steep, exposed rock faces and "crown" are the result of quarrying. Today, tennis courts, playing fields, and the Randall Museum all occupy large quarried areas.
